Outstanding Teacher Programme



Designed by OLEVI and facilitated by experienced school leaders and teachers, the Outstanding Teacher Programme (OTP) gives good and outstanding teachers a set of high level skills and strategies that enable them to become consistently and sustainably outstanding. The programme is facilitated over a ten week period and consists of two full days, five half day sessions, plus three sessions of in-school practice where peer planning and observation takes place.
